Dear Mr. Cashen:

This is in response to your request to obtain California registration of your diesel fuel additive called Centron.

For your information, California does not have a registration program for fuel additives. You can sell a fuel additive in California without any approval from the Air Resources Board (ARB) provided the fuel additive is registered with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) and contains no heavy metals. You have provided the ARB with copies of the U.S. EPA fuel additive registration for American Energy Group, Inc.'s fuel additives. You also submitted the Fuel Additive Manufacturer Notification for Centron Diesel Fuel Treatment, which indicated that the additive would be sold in consumer-sized containers for addition to a vehicle's fuel system by an individual. These documents meet the ARB's requirements. Therefore, you may market the fuel additive in California.
